






<p><b>Community</b></p> 	<p>Groups of populations living in the same area.</p>	<p><b>Limiting Factors</b></p> 	<p>Conditions that limit the growth, abundance, or distribution of an organism or a population of organisms.</p>
<p><b>Ecosystem</b></p> 	<p>The community plus all of the non-living surroundings.</p>	<p><b>Habitat</b></p> 	<p>A place where a living thing lives. An animal must have food, water, shelter, and space.</p>
